



Announcement of Photak Police Station

**Subject: Intention to not accept any kind of gifts from performing duties
(NO Gift Policy)**

Photak Police Station is committed to developing its operations with transparency, prioritizing public interest over personal gain, and avoiding conflicts of interest. This commitment aligns with the National Reform Plan on the Prevention and Suppression of Corruption and Misconduct (Revised Edition), which aims to ensure that government agencies operate with transparency, integrity, and without vested interests. In accordance with this policy, all government officials must refrain from accepting any form of gifts or gratuities in the performance of their duties (No Gift Policy).

Therefore, we hereby declare the intent of the Superintendent of Photak Provincial Police Station, together with all police officers, to strictly refrain from accepting any gifts or gratuities in the course of official duties. This is a unified commitment to fostering an organizational culture rooted in integrity, rejecting patronage, and avoiding actions that could influence impartiality or decision-making, which may lead to discrimination or undue advantage. Our goal is to prevent unfair practices, ensure transparency, and uphold the principles of good governance, thereby strengthening public trust in the fair and ethical conduct of police duties.

This declaration is thus publicly announced and shall be strictly observed by all officers.
